## **Membership Options**

At the Y, we know that one size doesn't fit all, and that includes membership plans. We offer several categories of membership to accommodate the varying needs of our community.

- Adult (one adult age 19-59)
- Couple (two adults sharing the same residence, age 19-59)
- Family (two adults and their dependents, including children age 23 and younger and disabled family members, sharing the same residence, see reverse for add-on information)
- Single Parent Family (one unmarried adult and his/her dependents, including children age 23 and younger and disabled family members, sharing the same residence)
- Senior Adult (one adult age 60 and older)
- Senior Couple (two adults sharing the same residence, at least one must be age 60 or older)
- Youth (one child age 3-18 or still in high school)
- College (one full-time college student, proof of status required)

Proof of residency will be required for each individual age 18 or older seeking to be included on a Couple or Family membership. The YMCA reserves the right to require a photo ID and/or other documentation to prove an individual's identity, residency and/or dependency.

#### **Payment Options**

Up to 3 additional adults (age 18 and over) sharing the same residence may be added to a Family membership at a cost of \$20 per month per member.

These rates are good from January 1, 2023 until December 31, 2023. A \$20 service fee will be applied to all rejected ACH or debit/credit transactions.

#### **Financial Assistance**

The Y is committed to serving the entire community, regardless of financial means. Our scholarship program grants financial assistance for membership and programs to qualified individuals and families. Scholarship applications can be picked up at our Welcome Center or downloaded from our website.

#### **Membership Cancellations**

Although we never want to see our members leave, we understand that sometimes circumstances change. Monthly withdrawals may be cancelled by completing a cancellation notice **IN PERSON** at the YMCA Welcome Center no less than **FIFTEEN (15) days** in advance of the next scheduled withdrawal. Memberships are non-refundable.

The YMCA conducts regular sex offender screenings on all members, participants, and guests. If a sex offender match occurs, the YMCA reserves the right to cancel membership, end program participation, and remove visitation access.
