TRI CO TOURNAMENT INFORMATION 2024

- 1. Gate- \$2 adults \$1 school aged children. Preschoolers are free. Coaches and players are free.
- 2. Home teams are determined by the higher seed in the first two rounds of double elimination. After round 2 the home team is determined by a flip of the coin. Round Robins will flip every game.
- 3. The top three teams will receive individual medals. If there are less than four teams tournament directors may choose to give medals to less places.
- 4. An all-star team will be announced after the championship game for 9-11, 11-14, and 14-18.
- 5. Should games get rained out the tournament schedule will be moved to the next playable day with the same schedule. If too many games get rained out, an abbreviated version of games may be implemented. This may include shortened time limits and/or starting at bats with a one and one count. Championship games are always played with regular time and at bat rules.
- 6. There are no predetermined dug outs. First come first serve.
- Please focus on sportsmanship. Abusive behavior will not be tolerated. If a player, coach or fan is thrown out of a game they must leave the ball park and may not return for the remainder of the tournament.
- 8. Approximately five minutes before the game begins, there will be a meeting at home plate with the head coach from each team.
- 9. While on defense coaches may not be on the field of play.
- 10. Reminder-if a player will be arriving late, do not include the player in the original line up. When the player arrives add them to the bottom of the lineup, even if this means they miss an at bat. Inform the other team's scorekeeper. There is no penalty for this.
- 11. Teams must have 7 players to start a game. After ten minutes it is a forfeit.
- 12. BASEBALL Pitch counts begin fresh with the first game of the tournament, regardless of how soon a game was played before the tournament began. There will be a mandatory one day break in the tournament before the championship game(s). Pitch counts will NOT be wiped clean before the championship game(s).
- 13. Since there is a six run rule and pitch counts are determined by innings, a pitcher can pitch an entire inning without reaching three recorded outs. If a pitcher finishes an inning with less than three outs, it is counted as an entire inning for pitch count purposes.
- 14. During Tournaments baseball pitch counts will be turned in to the tournament director prior to the start of games the next day.
